I hereby transfer to the Catholic University of Eichstätt-Ingolstadt (and on its request also to the German National Library in Frankfurt and/or Leipzig, the Landesbibliothek and the responsible special collections library) the non-exclusive right to store the submitted document(s) electronically and make it/them publicly accessible in data networks. No remuneration will be paid. My other copyrights will not be limited or restricted and I can additionally publish the work in part or in full at any time.

- 6. For doctoral theses: I hereby confirm that the publication of the doctoral thesis was approved by the doctoral committee and that the electronic form corresponds to the approved original version in form and content.
- 7. For habilitation theses: I hereby confirm that the electronic form of the habilitation thesis corresponds to the approved version in form and content.
